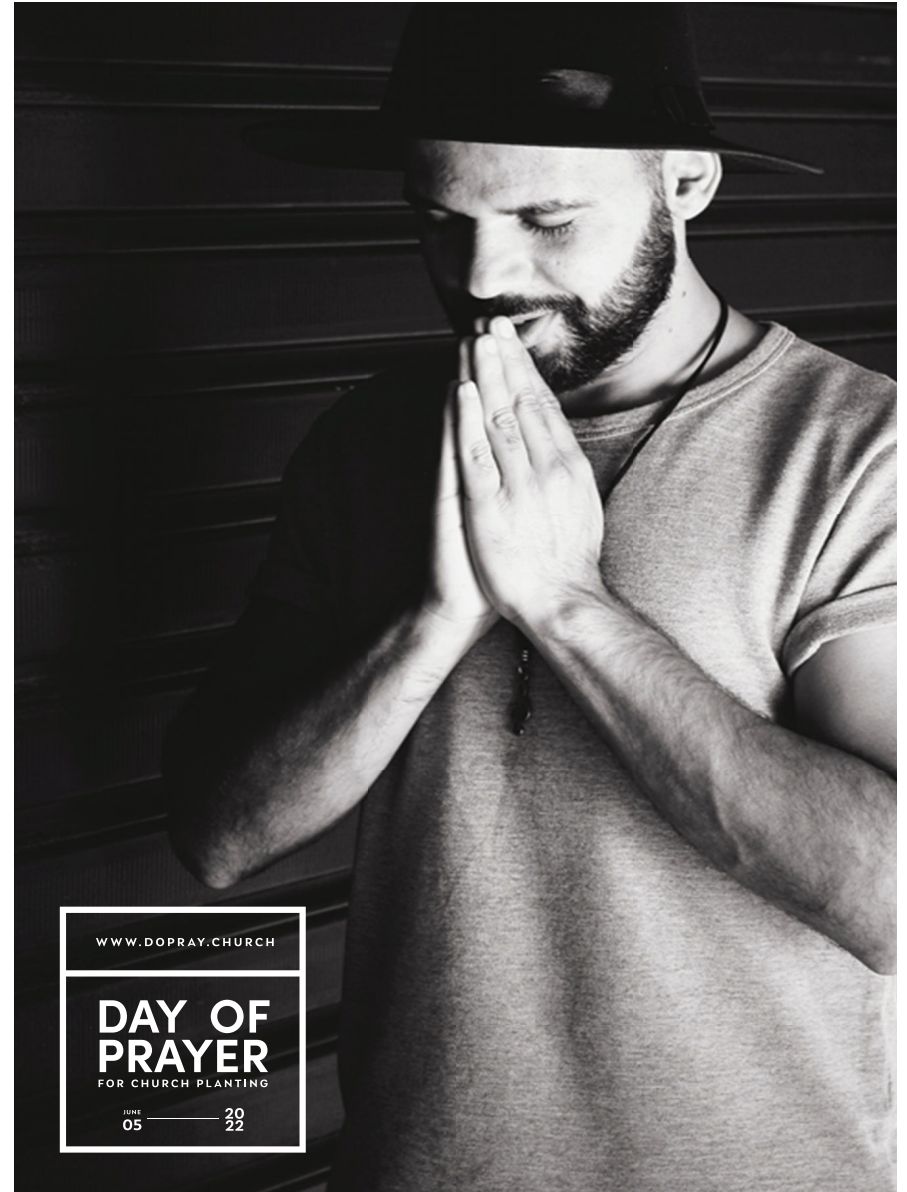

Reflective Thoughts:

The Need for Church Planting

Read: Ephesians 3:14–21

Highlights: “Now to him who is able to do far more abundantly than all that we ask or think...”

Pray:

1. Give thanks that we can play a role in church planting
2. Pray for wisdom of church leaders to be creative, but not compromise on the biblical vision of the church
3. Pray we see the same growth in church planting in the western world as we do in the majority world

Joseph Akakpoo | Lome, Togo

Joseph Akakpo leads a team of pastors in evangelism, discipling families, and planting churches in Togo.



Prayer Request: Joseph just launched a church plant in Kati Lomnava, Togo and Edokope is next. He’s praying for a water well to open the way and for a vehicle to reach bush communities that are strongholds of voodoo and witchcraft.

Service Opportunities

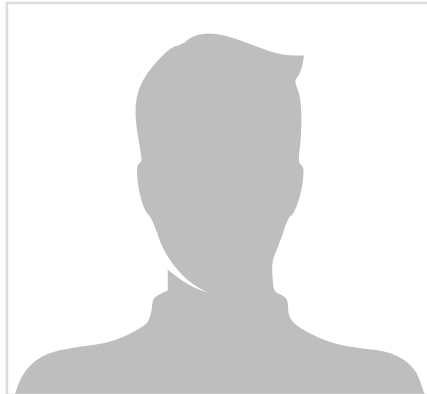
Read: 1 Corinthians 12:12-27

Highlights: "If anyone is above reproach..."

Pray:

1. Ask God to raise up more godly church planters
2. That we would see a movement of young people giving their lives to the task of planting churches
3. For the purity, godliness, & love of God for the next generation of church planters

Paul and Hannah train and lead a group of church planters who serve among Hindu populations in slums, universities, and middle-class communities.

Prayer Request: Pray for Paul and Hannah as they encourage national pastors, mentor their church planting team, and strengthen their newest church plant among the middle and upper-class urban community.



Reflective Thoughts:

A Global Movement

Read: Revelation 7:9-12

Highlights: "...from every nation, from all tribes and peoples and languages..."

Pray:

1. Give thanks for the gospel to be given to all peoples, races, and nations
2. Ask Jesus to root out pride, partiality, and favoritism in the church from local churches
3. Ask Jesus to give the church a love for all peoples

Adam & Melissa Gibson | Lisbon, Portugal

Adam and Melissa have planted a new church in the greater Lisbon area in Portugal and are working to grow that church and an international ministry through involvement in the community.

Prayer Request: We have been looking for a bigger building to purchase for the church plant that will give us more room to grow.



Reflective Thoughts:

Perseverance Amid Suffering

Read: 2 Corinthians 1:8-11

Highlights: "We felt that we had received the sentence of death. But that was to make us rely not on ourselves but on God who raises the dead."

Pray:

1. Ask Jesus to protect churches being planted from persecution
2. Rejoice that boldness in the midst of suffering leads others to be confident in the Lord
3. Pray for strengthening of exhausted pastors, missionaries, and church planters

A Missions minded, Filipino church focused on restoring lost people.
