ABWE began working in Togo in 1974 through the ministries of healthcare and education. Our vibrant outreaches in the country now include:



2 HOSPITALS

- hundreds of thousands of patients
- additional community health outreach
- mobile clinics and village development programs

MULTIPLE MINISTRIES

- school for the blind
- aquaponics farm
- Hope Radio - a Christian radio station
- translation ministries and more

100+ MISSIONARIES

- targeting 5 unreached people groups, ministering to Muslims and supporting church-planting ministries

But the spiritual & medical needs are still great.

- **50%** of the population practice Islam, voodoo or animism
- **10%** of adult deaths could be avoided
- **20%** of children's deaths are unnecessary
- **1** surgeon serves up to **1-million** people
- **50%+** of people who come to our hospital are turned away each day because of a lack of capacity

The HBB Vision Project will help renovate, enhance, and expand the hospital, support surgical and medical programs, and train Africans to use medical evangelism to share the gospel.



PLANS INCLUDE:

- Doubling in-patient capacity to 100 beds
- Building a larger chapel and outdoor amphitheater
- Building missionary and guest housing
- Creating a Pan-African Academy of Christian Surgeons (PAACS) training area
- Equipping Togolese medical personnel in medicine and evangelism
- Upgrading hospital equipment, including a digital radiography unit
- Renovating the ICU and Infectious Disease Ward
- Building a Peds/ICU/Women's/Men's wards
- Updating technology across the campus
- Improving the campus water system
- Building new patient family accommodations

We believe healthcare is a powerful tool for serving the physical and spiritual needs of a sick and hurting world.

In our nearly 90 years of ministry, we have seen compassionate medical care soften hearts to hear the important message of the gospel, changing lives for today and eternity.

The HBB Vision Project will update and expand the hospital complex and its supporting facilities so that hospital staff can multiply their witness to the Togolese population, while providing life-saving medical services.
