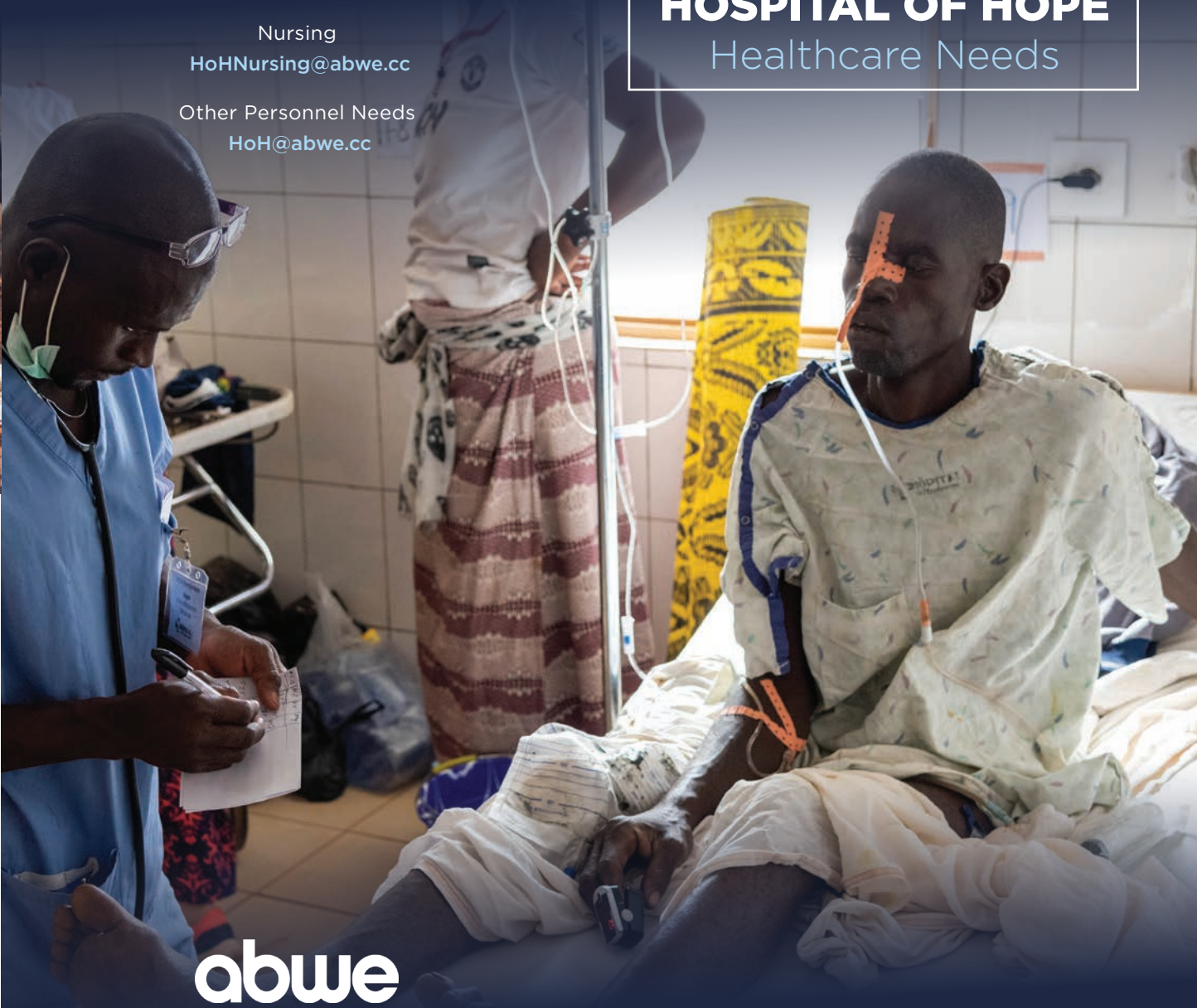

Every day patients arrive seeking quality medical care. They are welcomed and shown love through excellent facilities, a great staff and personalized care. Utilizing medicine, our multi-national medical team seeks to connect with each patient and establish open doors for our chaplains and missionaries to reach patients in their greatest times of need.

Our team of trained chaplains prays with patients and counsels families facing difficulties. They then follow up with patients in villages and develop disciples through chronological Bible studies. Thousands are given the opportunity to experience the love of Jesus and hear the Word of God through the digital resources the Hospital of Hope offers its patients both in the hospital and during follow up.

The Hospital of Hope, located in northern Togo, is a 65-bed hospital serving patients not only from Togo, but also from other West African countries including Benin, Burkina Faso, Ghana, Niger, and Nigeria.



STAFF

The Hospital of Hope team is comprised of more than 140 Togolese staff and over 40 Expats from the US, Canada, France and New Zealand who desire to show God's love and care to those living in this dry corner of West Africa.

FACILITIES

We offer an outpatient clinic with OB, medicine and surgery consults, as well as a room for basic dental care when dentists are available. The hospital is equipped with digital x-ray imaging and ultrasound as well as a full laboratory and pharmacy. Our patient wards include a neonatal unit, pediatrics, maternity, an intensive care unit, as well as a men's and women's unit, an emergency bay, three isolation rooms and four large operating rooms.
