

# A DANGEROUS **PRAYER GUIDE** FOR MISSIONS





“But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you, and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the end of the earth.” (Acts 1:8)

This prayer guide invites you to join God’s mission to reach the nations through intentional and bold prayer. We’ll pray in ever-widening circles—starting with yourself and your immediate sphere of influence, and expanding to the ends of the earth. Let’s pray bold prayers of faith and surrender that align our hearts with his purposes.

### **Sunday: Salvation and the Church**

“Only let your manner of life be worthy of the gospel of Christ... standing firm in one spirit, with one mind striving side by side for the faith of the gospel.” (Philippians 1:27-28)

Reflect: Praise God for his saving grace and his work in your local church. Pray that your congregation will stand united in Christ, build itself up in love, and boldly proclaim the gospel.

- Thank God for his saving grace and faithfulness in your church.
- Pray for your church leaders to seek his will and lead with humility and courage.
- Ask God to strengthen your church’s unity and resolve to strive together for the faith.
- Intercede for lost people who attend your church to find salvation.
- Let’s commit to praying courageously for our church and its gospel witness.

### **Monday: Holiness in Your Immediate Sphere**

“But seek first the kingdom of God and his righteousness, and all these things will be added to you.” (Matthew 6:33)

“Always be prepared to make a defense to anyone who asks you for a reason for the hope that is in you.” (1 Peter 3:15)

Reflect: Pursue holiness in your own life, and pray for the salvation of those in your family, workplace, and neighborhood. Be ready to live faithfully and share the gospel in your daily interactions.

- Pray for your personal sanctification and for God to grow you in obedience.
- Intercede for the salvation of your family, friends, coworkers, and neighbors.
- Ask for wisdom and boldness to give an answer for the hope within you.
- Seek God’s guidance in showing Christ’s love to your immediate sphere.

## Tuesday: Our Nation

“I urge that supplications, prayers, intercessions, and thanksgivings be made for all people, for kings and all who are in high positions, that we may lead a peaceful and quiet life.” (1 Timothy 2:1-2)

Reflect: As citizens, we are called to pray for our leaders and for the gospel to spread across our nation. Repent of our country's sins and ask God to bring revival.

- Pray for wisdom, integrity, and humility for national and local leaders.
- Ask for the gospel to spread and bring repentance and revival across the U.S.
- Intercede for repentance from sins such as idolatry, greed, and immorality.
- Seek God's blessing on missionaries and churches working in North America.

## Wednesday: Latin America

“For I am not ashamed of the gospel, for it is the power of God for salvation to everyone who believes.” (Romans 1:16)

Reflect: In Latin America, many blend traditional religions and superstitions with nominal Catholicism. Pray for them to know the true gospel and be transformed by the Spirit.

- Pray for nominal Catholics to encounter the gospel of grace.
- Ask for boldness for missionaries reaching those steeped in religious tradition.
- Seek God's power to break the hold of superstition and false practices.
- Pray for the church in Latin America to grow in purity and truth.

## Thursday: Secular Europe

“For although they knew God, they did not honor him as God or give thanks to him, but they became futile in their thinking.” (Romans 1:21)

Reflect: Europe is spiritually hardened, relying on wealth, comfort, and human consensus. Pray for repentance and for a renewed awareness of the need for a Savior.

- Pray for secularists to see the futility of relying on material wealth and ease.
- Ask for God's Spirit to convict hearts and open them to the truth of Christ.
- Intercede for boldness and faithfulness among the few gospel-preaching churches.
- Seek repentance and spiritual renewal across the continent.



## Friday: The Muslim World

“Even if we or an angel from heaven should preach to you a gospel contrary to the one we preached to you, let him be accursed.” (Galatians 1:8)

Reflect: Millions of Muslims worship every Friday, seeking salvation through works. Pray that their eyes would be opened to the grace of Christ and the truth of the gospel.

- Pray that Muslims would come to see the grace offered through Christ.
- Pray for Muslims to see the futility of works-based religion.
- Ask for dreams, visions, and gospel encounters to draw Muslims to Christ.
- Intercede for missionaries to have wisdom, safety, and boldness in their ministry.
- Seek breakthroughs in hard-to-reach Islamic nations.



## Saturday: Asia (Hindus and Buddhists)

“You turned to God from idols to serve the living and true God.” (1 Thessalonians 1:9)

Reflect: Asia is filled with spiritual darkness, where many worship idols and false gods. Pray for their deliverance from idolatry and salvation through Christ.

- Pray for Hindus and Buddhists to turn from idols to the living God.
- Ask for the gospel to penetrate cultures resistant to change and Western influence.
- Intercede for missionaries to adapt wisely and faithfully in their context.
- Seek freedom for those trapped in pagan rituals and spiritual oppression.



## Sunday: Sending from Your Church

“I make it my ambition to preach the gospel, not where Christ has already been named.” (Romans 15:20)

“How will they preach unless they are sent?” (Romans 10:15)

Reflect: The Great Commission is not optional. Pray for your church to send workers to the harvest fields where Christ is not yet known.

- Pray for God to raise up laborers from your church to go to the unreached.
- Intercede for those with evangelistic gifts to step forward boldly.
- Seek the Spirit's guidance for whom to send and where to send them.
- Commit to encouraging and supporting missionaries from your church.
